(conducted on 10th July 2024)


Poems are an integral part of school education as they help in language development and expression.

The presentation emphasized the transformative impact of inventions on our lives, showcasing how creativity can drive progress. The students' confidence and teamwork left the audience spellbound.




Other Achievements

Saanvi was declared the winner. She bagged the trophy in the under eleven category in the tournament.






Sports
